BAPS is the over-arching framework

- High-level endorsement
- Provides direction for the decade ahead
- Emphasizes partnerships, coordination, user/producer dialogue, & data accessibility
- Recognizes innovative approaches to data production
- Urges sustained funding



Drivers of demand anticipated in BAPS

1. Data for the Post-2015 framework
2. Priority Statistical Domains
3. Country level policy needs
4. Openness Agenda



The Bank is responding to demands

- **Maximizing data accessibility & usability**
 - Curation, documentation of household & labor surveys, admin data sources (with IHSN, ILO, PARIS21)
 - Data exchange between agencies & organizations (with FAO, ILO)
 - Open Data assessments & implementation support (with ODI, OKF)



The Bank is responding to demands

- **Standards, pilots, research, & analysis**
 - Standards for priority domains (FAO, ILO, UNSD/UNWomen, SEEA)
 - Piloting tools & training (UNSD, PARIS21)
 - Innovations to collect high frequency data (various)
 - Enhancements of user / producer dialogue (Sunlight Foundation, others)



The Bank is responding to demands

- **Country & Regional Statistical Capacity Building**
 - Coordinated country support (small & large scale) (many partners)
- **Formalizing Partnerships**
 - MOU with MDBs (and UN) on capacity building for post-2015
 - Clarifying IHSN governance and cooperation
 - Joint actions(Agriculture, Gender, Labor)



Bank Financing Instruments

- Array of instruments provides the flexibility to support BAPS actions and partnerships
 - STATCAP, SRF/CF, TFSCB, ECASTAT, IHSNTF, DGF
- However, there are funding shortages (in Bank instruments and in other agencies)



Conclusion

- BAPS provides the framework
- Increasing demands for data at global and country level
- Instruments in place to cover activities - but not the funding
- Better coordination of country-level activities & global efforts (e.g. standards, research, tools, survey instruments, funding mismatches)
- Step up user/producer dialogues at national & global levels
