



Explanatory Note on PRESS 2010 Data

The data collected in the 2010 Round of the Partner Report on Support to Statistics (PRESS) are available for free download on the PARIS21 website (<http://www.paris21.org/PRESS2010>). The data are presented in an **MS Excel file pivot table**. Users have access to all data collected across all PRESS rounds; however, it should be recognised that not all fields contain data across all rounds. If users have any difficulty with the file or any questions, they are invited to contact the PARIS21 Secretariat (contact@paris21.org).

The fields in the pivot table are explained below. By default, there exists an additional field (*Sum of Total Support USD*) that adds the financial and non-financial support of each record into a single figure.

FIELDS IN EXCEL PIVOT TABLE

PressID = ID assigned to each record by PRESS database

Reporterid = numeric ID of reporter in PRESS DB

reportername = Name of reporter

Reported Year

Regions

Identifier = Project ID specified by reporter or defined by PRESS when missing.

Programme Name

Statistical Area = statistical area in text format

Statistical Area number = statistical area in numeric format

Commitment Date

Expected End Date

Financing Instrument = grant or Loan/credit

Financing Approach = *Stand-alone project/programme ; Component of project/programme ; Budgetary support*

Financing Mechanism = *Not-co-financed; Financing through intermediary organization; Joint or pooled financing*

Purpose: *Technical assistance (technical expertise, consultant services); Training; Goods and equipment; Operating costs (recurrent expenditures); Other*

Commitment_USD

Non financial support_USD

Collaboration = *yes / no*

Collaborators = name of collaborators if any

Role: *lead donor; other donor: implementation*

Aligned = Alignment with national priorities
