## Badges & Security



Few days prior the meeting, you will receive an automated email containing a flash code that will give you access to the OECD premises. **Please print this flash code mail or have it easily accessible on a mobile device.** Check in your spam folder in case you cannot find it.

On arrival, **you must register at the Reception desk of OECD Boulogne** to obtain your visitor's badge. You will need to present photo identification and the above-mentioned flash code.

Please plan to arrive well in advance before the meeting, especially on the first day, to allow sufficient time for the security and registration formalities. Participants can arrive from 8:30am, and we suggest no later than 8:45am.

For security reasons, you must wear your visitor's badge at all times. Badges must be handed in upon departure. A box is provided for this purpose at each exit.

### Bus routes

- 52, 72, 126, 160, 175, 467 – Pont de Saint-Cloud bus stop

### Tramway

- T2 – Saint-Cloud station (15 minutes by foot)

- Within 300 metres
